For the duration of the exhibition, the pavilion will become a workplace for the archive *Standard Euro*. Artist *Anne Metzen* searches for traces and engages in research along the interface between various media and disciplines. Her meticulous investigations and process-oriented archiving of the phenomenon of everyday life and of daily world events under the watchwords standardization, scaling, and formalization find expression in an artistic image, in work having an object character, and in a constantly growing and cumulative installation, the archive *Standard Euro*. Emerging from the sum of investigations into simple, discrete observations is a complex space of thought, and one that integrates visitors to the courtyards. The exhibition project will also be used to generate an info packet on location based on the collected results and activities related to *Standard Euro*.
