For years now, Vienna-based artist **Katharina Heinrich** has been preoccupied with meshwork or netted structures. Her handmade network or woven pieces reflect rigorous formal principles while producing a multiplicity of variable bodily forms. The patterning of the meshwork is generated by the intersection of the X and Y axes – the classical parameters of spatial structure. On the basis of a spatial framework, which constitute the Z axis, the artist creates three-dimensional forms, sculptures whose flexible materiality and mobility of function endows them with a versatile character. Accordingly, Katharina Heinrich refers to her production process as a “sculptural act.”

Heinrich designs both bodies as well as spaces, and her ambiguous pieces oscillate perceptually while eluding clear-cut categorization. They are transformed via the intervention of the user's body, taking shape only in relation to the surroundings. As a result, Heinrich expands the concept of sculpture in the direction of the fluid and the biomorphic.

For the *A trans Pavilion*, Katharina Heinrich has produced floating, functional spatial figures which encompass the non-visible along the visible while emphasizing the presence of interstitial space. The relationship between inner and outer is renegotiated as visitors are invited to embark upon an intimate journey of discovery – with potentially astonishing results.

The exhibition opening will take place on Saturday, May 21, 2011 at 4 p.m. You and your friends are cordially invited to attend.
