Strongly influenced by events and interactions from diverse sources in the moment they occur such as travels, people, words, phrases, sounds, ideas, and emotions, the Canadian artist Mareike Lee amasses these elements and fragments in a non-linear fashion over time. Translated into objects, drawings, photos, sound, video, and books, Lee has developed several site-specific installations. The exhibitions are a combination of cumulative processes and spontaneous decision-making dependent on the context.

Using the glass and concrete box-structure of the A trans Pavilion as a template, Mareike Lee will create an installation that makes the boundaries between inside and outside porous and not so clear-cut.
