Traversata takes up the idea of the journey and presents reflections and questions posed by Italian artist and curator Nicola Sansò on themes such as transition, re-localization, alienation, the fluidity of time and space, loss and flight. Foregrounded by Traversata is transition as a process of dislocation, reconnection, and contact between various cultures. Displaced, realigned, and dislocated are both objects and people. A perspective opens up onto fragmented, riven, and fragmented landscapes, places in states of transformation – ranging from the ruins of the former Italsider steel works in Taranto, to Giò Ponti's cathedral in Taranto, to urban agglomerations in Berlin-Mitte. With its strongly evocative character, this installation superimposes various locations in order to display a holistic image of the relationship between bodies and designed space, between individual and environment. Traversata invites spectators to traverse (traversare) the threshold of the A trans Pavilion and to experience the emptiness of the exhibition space – with its small number of selected photographs – in a new way.
